




2. Digital access to data is a critical component of flexible work




Frontline work practices are becoming more digital, automated and data driven




Reason 1: How we derive business value is evolving

Q. What is the impact of automation technologies on employee experience?




Reason 2: Human development is inextricably linked with technology development

Greatest impact of GenAl on work transformation





Q: Is your organization currently deploying or planning to deploy any of the following **automation technologies** in the next 18 months?



How to Build Business Value



1. Prepare to capitalize on new ways of working

Consider how you will capture data across digital and physical work environments as work becomes increasingly instrumented, interconnected and intelligent

2. Consider what new skills and jobs roles will be key

Integrate skills development and data analytics into resource plans – without skilled workers with both human and technical acumen, you will miss out on harvesting business insights

3. Continuously adapt and innovate

Invest in AI-enabled technologies and secure ways of working that build confidence in data and leadership alike; build an ecosystem of people, systems, and information in the spirit of innovation
