

# Benefits of Intelligent Data Capture

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## Challenges

The flow of documents through your organization, known as the document workflow, can reveal a lot about the efficiency, speed and security of the processes and data your business relies on. This is worth a close look, especially with employees working remotely, and many connecting with personal devices.

Invoice processing offers a good example, as it can readily be transformed by invoice automation. Alex is an accounting manager at an engineering firm. One of the challenges of her job is the continued use of paper invoices. Since the company also receives electronic invoices, her accounts payable workflow is more complex than it needs to be.
